PRESCHOOL

Trinity's preschool offers 2-day morning classes for 3 year old children, 3-day morning classes for 4 year old children and 5-day afternoon classes for older 4's and 5 year olds. This Christ-centered program of developmental readiness prepares young children for success in school. Socialization, listening skills, letter recognition and number concepts, large and small motor, activities are nurtured in a loving Christian environment that teaches children that learning is fun and exciting.



BIBLE (K-8)

Every day begins with instruction in God's Word. Students learn their identity as part of God's creation. They learn that all people are sinful and in need of a Savior. Trinity students learn of God's love for them and the forgiveness offered by the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Trinity students learn that their lives are a response to that tremendous gift of forgiveness. In all we do, we strive to bring glory to God.

LANGUAGE ARTS

Trinity offers a strong foundation of phonics and word attack skills. Trinity teachers monitor student literacy progress through a program called "Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills" (Dibels). Teachers quickly intervene when student skills are weak or missing, and supplement those students whose literacy skills are exceptional.

A strong program of integrated reading comprehension, creative writing, spelling, and grammar is supplemented with the Accelerated Reader program. At Trinity, students are not only taught reading skills, they are taught to love to read!



SCIENCE

Concepts of Physics, Biology, and Earth Science are taught from a Christian worldview. Trinity students enjoy a well-stocked science lab with many opportunities for hands-on learning. Science labs, investigations and other science related field trips and activities are encouraged.



MATH

Our outstanding math program teaches foundational concepts and thinking skills in a cyclical format that increases student learning retention and application. A focus on the building blocks of addition and multiplication facts sets the stage for advanced problem solving and real world application. Trinity students learn spreadsheet concepts and applications as a supplement to their basic math instruction. Opportunities for academic advancement are available as Trinity teaches 9th grade Algebra to a select group of able 8th grade students.

SOCIAL STUDIES

Students learn who they are in relationship to their Creator. They learn respect for parents, adults, and peers. Trinity students learn about God's plan for their lives and the world in an ever growing focus of family, community, state, country and world. New Hampshire history, geography, U.S. history, civics and world history are brought together and taught as part of God's greater plan for humanity.

TECHNOLOGY

Computers are available to students within each classroom and in the media center computer lab. Basics of computer instruction are provided so that computer technology may be applied to advance curriculum objectives of writing, math, thinking skills, and research. Instruction in keyboarding, word processing, internet search, spreadsheet, web design and multimedia presentation are facilitated by our advanced computer network.
